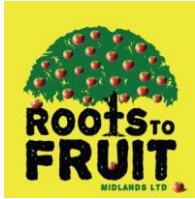

	Hazard/Harm	Existing Control Measures
1	<p>Don't Get Run Over</p> <p>Traffic Impact Serious injury</p>	10 MPH speed limit is in place on the nursery, please take care when wondering around the nursery and watch out for traffic.
2	<p>Take Care of Your Back</p> <p>Heavy lifting. Machinery and equipment. compost bags, large pots, garden waste Muscular injury back injuries from lifting heavy or awkward loads,. long term back injuries from repeated strain on back, other injuries from dropping loads e.g. on feet</p>	Please be careful when lifting heavy items, bent at the knees and keep your back straight and hold the load close to your body. Ask for help if the load is too heavy. Use a trolley or wheel barrow when necessary
3	<p>Don't Fall Over</p> <p>Slips and trips Twisted ankle/ cuts and abrasions Wet conditions/ Slips and trips from surface debris</p>	Please take care when walking around the nursery and allotments some of the surfaces are uneven and when the weather is wet or during cold weather you will need to take extra care by watching where you walk, not rushing and planning routes carefully.
4	<p>Scratches and allergic reactions to plants</p>	Wear gloves keeping covered up.
5	<p>Watch Your feet</p> <p>Dropping heavy items on feet</p>	Careful how you carry things we strongly advise you wear sensible safety boots when working.
6	<p>Careful When Using Tools</p> <p>Injury through hitting body parts with a hammer/ mallet./mattock/pick/bar</p>	Take care when using tools, try not to let yourself be distracted, we strongly advise you wear sensible safety boots when working. Wear gloves.
7	<p>Cuts and Abrasions</p> <p>Accidents from pruning and sawing</p>	Wearing gloves safe use induction Take care when using tools, try not to let yourself be distracted.
8	<p>Poked and scratched in the eyes</p> <p>by branches and brambles</p>	Wearing gloves and warning others in the area, be careful and choose safe routes use eye protection if in a bad area
9	<p>Careful When Using Tools</p> <p>Tools and equipment e.g. forks, spades, shears, broken pots, other sharp tools</p>	Keep equipment maintained in good condition and fit for purpose e.g. handles are secure Suitable ergonomic features e.g. non slip handles

	Risks – puncture or entrapment injuries from contact with equipment	Suitable storage e.g. protection on blades so can be handled Wear personal protective equipment. Don't leave tools lying around for yourself and others to trip over.
1 0	Weather e.g. hot weather, heavy rain, cold weather	Be aware of risks e.g. sunburn, cold/hot weather Personal protective equipment e.g. waterproofs, Wellingtons, sun cream and correct clothing.

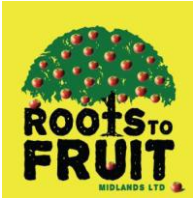

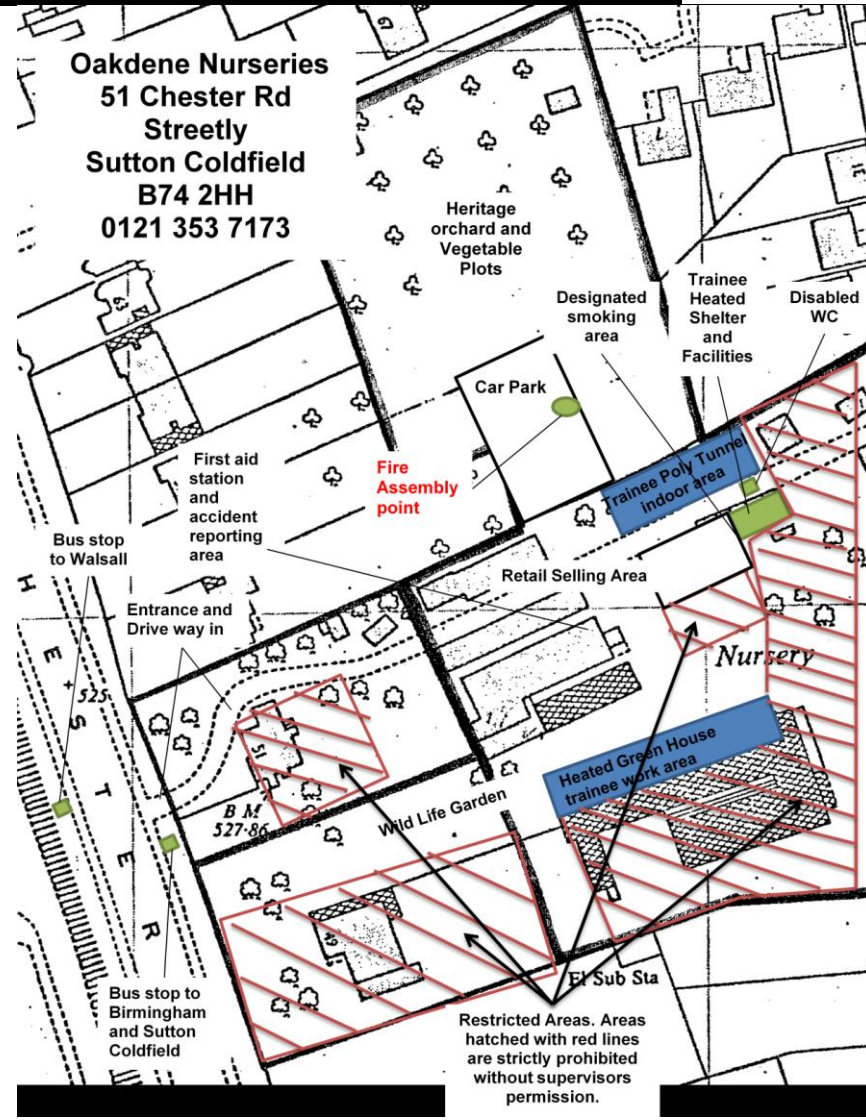
It is our aim to promote, set and maintain the highest standards for health, safety and welfare matters. This will be achieved by:

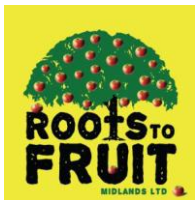
- providing adequate control of health and safety risks arising from the activities we undertake;
